The **Ag. Mechanics contest** will begin promptly at 8:30am. <u>As a reminder, this is a qualifying contest</u>. Registration will be from 7:00-8:00am in front of the Ag. Mechanics Shop located on McKee Street. McKee Street is the only side street that borders the high school. The Ag. Department will be on the right side of the street. The contests will conclude at around 12:30pm followed by a free lunch for all students and advisors/coaches in the cafeteria. Sub-contest awards will be announced after lunch in the ag. shop. Bring code approved tools for Welding, Electrical, Oxy -Fuel, and Cold Metal. You will also need to bring a small bench vise or standing vice for cold metal. Please make sure your students bring their own tools, floral tape, floral adhesive, and they may bring their own ribbon. <u>Please no pre-made bows</u>.
